

Current Reticulated Water Restrictions



Townships of Kilkivan, Goomeri, Amamoor & Kandanga are now on LEVEL 4 water restrictions until further notice. Level 4 restriction have been enforced as water storage is currently less than 20%. The below activities are banned until further notice:-

Restriction Details
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Garden Watering- odd numbers on odd days of the month/even numbers on even days of the month, between the hours of before 8am and after 4pm: Bucket only; Grass watering totally banned Total car & house washing ban (except cleaning of motor vehicle windscreens, mirrors and registration plates to meet traffic regulations & safety requirements), Total ban on commercial water carters sourcing water from local reticulated network. Total ban on filling (or topping up) swimming pools Individual metered water usage may be monitored and pressure restrictions applied. Non-residential users required to have at least 3 water efficiency measures in place and users over 1ML/Year required to have Water Efficiency Management Plan in place to access potable reticulated water supply.

The townships of Gympie, Imbil, Tin Can Bay, Cooloola Cove & Rainbow Beach have permanent Level 1 water restrictions, being

- o Even street numbers can use sprinklers before 8am and after 4pm on even days of month;
- o Odd street numbers can use sprinklers before 8am and after 4pm on odd days of month.

Your co-operation will ensure that there is ample water for all other users.

All reticulated water supplies areas on Level 1 water restrictions have the following permanent outdoor water usage restrictions in place:-

Filling Pools	By Council permit with Council standpipe	Any time
Topping Up Pools	Trigger or nozzle hose	Any time
Cleaning Paving and Driveways	Trigger or nozzle hose/ pressure cleaner [#]	Any time
Non-Residential Uses	Method	Times
Over 1 ML/Year Users	Water Efficiency Management Plan required	
Watering Outdoors	Bucket, trigger or nozzle hose	Any time
	Sprinkler or drip irrigation*	4pm–8am
Vehicle Washing	Bucket/trigger or nozzle hose/ pressure cleaner [#]	Any time
Cleaning Paving and Driveways	Trigger nozzle/pressure cleaner [#]	Any time

*No pooling or run-off permitted

[#]No off-site run-off permitted

Customers may apply for a Conditional Restrictions Permit in circumstances such as newly laid turf.

Water saving devices are rainwater tanks, pool covers and any plumbing, sanitary products or whitegoods which are WELs (Water Efficiency Labelling Scheme) certified, i.e. have the blue water stars on the item or packaging.
