		QBCC Confirmation of Insurance from builder (where work value >\$3,300) Note that a contract must be entered into with the licensed building contractor OR Owner Builders Permit is required (where work value >\$11,000).
		ONE copy of a Site Plan (scale 1:500) showing location of: a-Swimming Pool b-Fences, Gate and direction of swing of gate c-Filtration Equipment d-Houses, other buildings on site, location of septic tank, trenches & effluent disposal area, and Council's sewer main & house drains e-Disposal area for backwash (sand filter) and excess water f-Resuscitation signage g-Details of any doors or windows within a building that forms part of the pool enclosure h-Distance from the pool water to the property's road boundary (front), nearest side & rear boundary & nearest building in metres
		ONE copy of the Swimming Pool (scale 1:100) construction details including: a-Cross section and elevations b-Location of ladders and pool depths c-Hydrostatic valve location and size d-Earthing Provisions if applicable e-Engineering Certificate if applicable (certification required if concrete construction)
