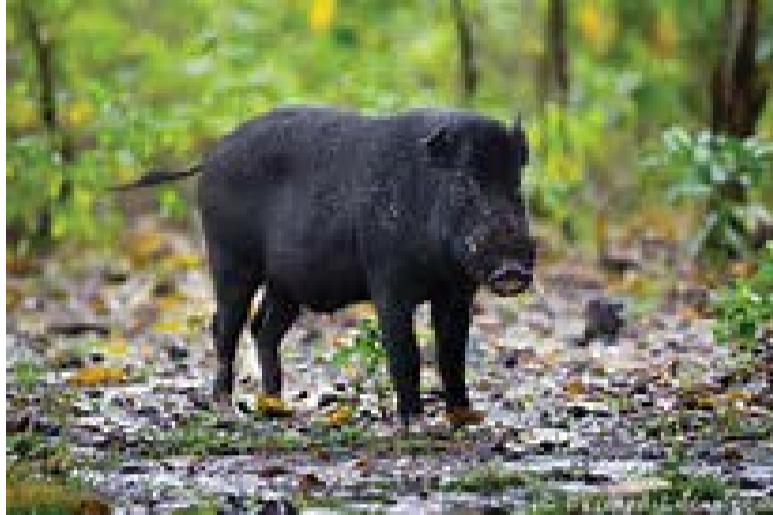


1080 Coordinated Baiting August/September 2021

Are wild dogs or feral pigs impacting your property/business?

1080 baiting may be an option for management of these declared pests.



To participate, apply to Council by 23 August 2021 on 1300 307 800.

Participants are required to:

- Understand 1080 baiting obligations – ask for a 1080 Baiting Information Pack.
- Notify neighbouring properties within a 1.5km radius, 72 hours prior to baiting day.
- Supply meat baits (minimum weight is 250g for wild dogs/foxes, 500g for feral pigs).
- Attend a Bait Station (listed below) to have baits injected with 1080.
- On the day, provide all required paperwork, sign the Deed Poll and collect signage.
- Lay the 1080 baits. Fresh 1080 meat baits CANNOT be stored.

Goomeri	Gympie Regional Council Depot, Hayden Drive	Wednesday 8 September 8am-10am
Kilkivan	Old Gympie Regional Council Depot, Gatehouse Road (end of Fraser Street, next to Waste Water Treatment Plant)	Thursday 9 September 8am-10am
