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**1. BACKGROUND AND PREVIOUS COUNCIL CONSIDERATION**

The State Government has recently issued a drought declaration for the Gympie Regional Council Area.

**2. REPORT**

The drought declaration was made after the Ordinary Meeting of 8 March 2017 and the Mayor has requested that consideration be given to the matter. In the past Council has made amendments to its rating payment structures for both drought and flood. A previous action which Council could consider applying in this instance is an extension of the interest free period.

Currently Council will apply interest to rate payments made after 11 May 2017. An extension of this date for three (3) months would provide a concession to primary producers impacted by the drought conditions. The concession would only apply to the primary producer rating classification.


