## Parking in loading zones



## (Attachment to Commercial Vehicle Permit HEF616)

- 1. A commercial vehicle may be lawfully parked in a loading zone subject to the conditions specified on any official traffic sign. (Maximum 15 minutes).
- 2. A person must not park a vehicle in a loading zone otherwise than for the unloading or loading of goods safe as otherwise set out in this local law.
- 3. A vehicle may be lawfully parked in a loading zone for as long as necessary to set down passengers or to pick up passengers who are waiting at the loading zone to be picked up.
- 4. However, a vehicle is not lawfully parked in a loading zone under subsection (1), (2) or (3) if the vehicle is parked contrary to the provisions of an official traffic sign or, in the case of a commercial vehicle, if the vehicle is parked in contravention of conditions specified on an official traffic sign.
- 5. An emergency vehicle may be lawfully parked in a loading zone if it is reasonably necessary to park the vehicle in the loading zone to deal with an emergency.
- 6. A non-commercial vehicle may be lawfully parked in a loading zone for a period not exceeding 5 minutes for the purpose of loading or unloading goods only.
