

How to Record an Observation

Step 1: Take a photo (if you can)

We recommend you download a free app called TimeStamp Camera Free. Use this app to take a photo and it will automatically place a watermark on your photo with the GPS location, accuracy, address, date, and time.

The first time you open the app, tap the clock symbol and turn the GPS on by selecting the second option in the dropdown list as per the photo displayed.

You can also turn on a map, altitude and compass.






Step 1:

Take a photo using a free camera App called Timestamp Camera Basic



Step 2: Submit a recording using 'Wildwatch Gympie'



You can find the link on Gympie Regional Council's website at www.gympie.qld.gov.au/wildwatch. Click on the 'Wildwatch Gympie' link and open the web app.

Step 2:

Click on 'Proceed as Guest'.

If using a smartphone or tablet, the app may ask you to share your location, please click 'yes' for the app to accurately mark your location. Otherwise ensure your location services are turned on. See FAQ for more information on how to do this.


Hint: Once you open the url app, you can save it as a short-cut on your phone or desktop to access it regularly. Refer to FAQ on how to do this.




Step 5: Fill out the form and ensure you fill out all required field

Locate via geotagged photo (recommended): Add a photo from your camera roll (preferably geotagged and stamped). If geotagged, the location will automatically display as a small grey circle on the map.
