Timing

Construction commenced in February 2023 on the Maudsley Street, Goomeri project and, current to February 2024, this project and the Cedar Pocket Road Bridge Approaches are complete.

Work is currently underway on the Moy Pocket Road Floodways and is targeted to be complete in early April 2024. The remaining listed projects will be rolled-out through the remainder of 2024, weather permitting.
