Summary

Gympie Regional Council is pleased to announce the Gympie region has been activated for the Reconstruction of Essential Public Asset (REPA) relief measures available under the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA) as a result of;

- Ex-Tropical Cyclone Seth, 29 December 2021 10 January 2022
- South East Queensland Rainfall and Flooding, 22 February 5 April 2022
- Southern Queensland Flooding, 6 20 May 2022

Council acknowledges the assistance provided through the jointly funded Commonwealth-State Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA).

Landslip Works proposed

For Blunder Road, the landslip remediation work activities include:

- Clear and remove existing vegetation within the limit of works for remediation.
- Excavate road to remove loose, unsuitable material and provide benched profile earthwork reinstatement.
- Install geotextile and place rockfill.
- Reinstate pavement to existing levels, and
- Reinstate table drain to toe of batter.

For Booubyjan Road, the landslip remediation work activities include:

- Clear and remove existing vegetation within the limit of works for remediation.
- Removal of loose rocks
- Anchoring rocks where required

Associated road work repairs adjacent to the landslip sites will be carried out where applicable.
